2. Read and respond to the article, [Responsive Web Design in the Browser Part 1: Kill Photoshop](#), from the [Treehouse blog](#).

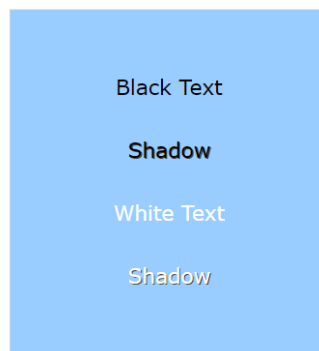
